## SUBJECT SNAPSHOT - RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

### EYFS

Reception have been learning about Easter. They have read the Easter story and talked about how Easter is celebrated. They have also talked about how they have celebrated Easter at home in the past.



### Year Two

Year Two have been learning about respecting each other's thoughts, feelings and beliefs whilst discussing Easter symbols such as Easter Eggs.
