SUBJECT SNAPSHOT - MFL

<u>Year One</u>

Year One have been using the Spanish vocabulary that they know (colours and numbers) whenever they can in their day. Their tables are coloured and they are often asked to sit at tables using the colours in Spanish – ask them what blue, green, red, yellow and orange are.



<u>Year Three</u>

Year Three have been thinking about conversational Spanish. They have been practising their greetings and using these to have small conversations. They have also learnt that there are multiple ways to say hello and goodbye.
