SUBJECT SNAPSHOT



Little Jesters

The magic of autumn has been a huge focus this term. The children have painted fireworks using finger painting and created their own conker prints.

Reception
Autumn has been a focus for Reception this term. They have loved finger painting and produced a brilliant display of their trees.



Year 2

Year 2 have been looking at drawing skills. They have been experimenting with texture using a range of mark making.



Year 1

There has been a big focus on mark making this term. Year 1 linked their bee drawings with The Creation Story in R.E. They used a watercolour wash to give their finished piece that extra sparkle.



Year 3

Year 3 have created their own imaginative drawing after experimenting with shading and pattern. They used a poem as a stimulus to draw a creature in close-up.



Year 4

The children have used different qualities of mark – line, tone and texture and experimented with how rubbers can be used for effect. They used pencils, graphite sticks and rubbers to create a final piece based on the story of Jeffrey the Maggot.

Year 5

Year 5 have looked at the portrait work of Frank Auerbach and discussed his use of mark, line and tone in his black and white portraits. They then used his "working in the negative" approach with graphite, chalk and rubbers to demonstrate techniques used to show shadow.



Year 6

Year 6 studied the tonal work of Andy Warhol. Children were given an image and had to identify the light, middle and dark ranges. Using ready mix paint, they then had to show a clear tonal contrast in a photocopied image of music legend Taylor Swift.
