# SUBJECT SNAPSHOT



## Little Jesters

Little Jesters have made good use of the woods this term. They have been on a leaf hunt for ingredients to make their own potions.



## Reception

Reception have been using the great weather to be out in the woods and looked at the various habitats they could find. They then constructed their own using the natural materials they had found.

## Year 2

Year 2 have been constructing their own survival structure. They went down to the woods to find all the natural resources they would need and then had great fun trying to make them secure.



## Year 1

The children have been immersed in the story of The Three Little Pigs. They then had to design and build their own house using junk modelling, sellotape and the help of a glue gun to provide a sound structure which could not be blown down by the big bad wolf



## Year 3

This term, Year 3 have sewn their own glove puppets. They designed superheroes and then chose the coloured fabrics to sew together using a running stitch.



## Year 4

As part of their survival theme, Year 4 spent time in the woods constructing rafts and shelters. They found making their structures secure to be a challenge!



## Year 5

Year 5 have designed their own recreational vehicle. They had to try and include as many features as possible. Then, using cardboard, they had to recreate their design, remembering to include all the features in their design.



## Year 6

Year 6 have been designing and constructing life rafts using resources found in and around the woods. They then had to test them to see if they could withstand weight and evaluated them, suggesting improvements to their design.
