Year 3

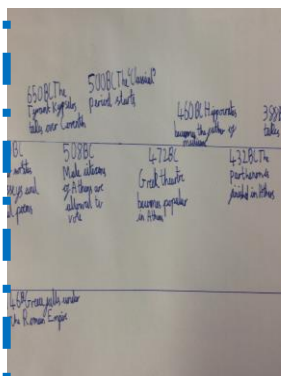
Year 3 have been investigating Roman History and looked at what life was like following orders as a Roman soldier.
