We will be exploring the books of Eric Carle this term.

Through them, we will further explore our animal topic and use inspiration for our own writing and artwork.

Year One



We will be starting to look at writing in first person through diaries and letters about our animal discoveries. We will finish the term exploring poetry and creating our own poems relating to our senses.

In Geography we will be exploring the world's continents and oceans and identifying where we are from street to planet. We will also be learning key geographical vocabulary to be able to describe key geographical features across the globe.

Christianity – We are learning to identify when it is easy and difficult to show friendship and explore when Jesus may have found it difficult.

We will be learning about David Attenborough and other key individuals surrounding the identification and conservation of animals. We will also be looking at key animals that played a part in different areas of history from Dolly the Sheep (the first animal clone) to Cher Ami (the pigeon that saved the Lost Battalion).



This term's Science is identifying different kind of animals. We will be looking at animal features and finding different ways to group them.

For Art this term we will be focusing on the collages in our key texts by Eric Carle and creating our own collaged animals.




In DT, we will be preparing for the RSPB bird watch by using our measuring and food prep skills to create bird feeders to attract a range of British birds to our school.
