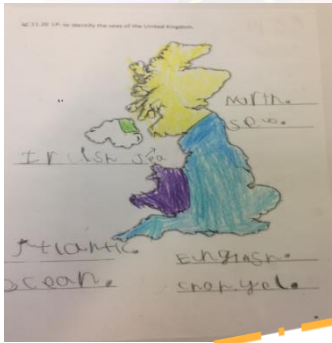
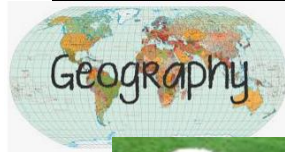

# SUBJECT SNAPSHOT



## Year 1

Year one have been investigating parts of the United Kingdom, identifying key features and being able to say if it is coastal, city, town or rural area.



## Reception

Have been going into the forest this term and completing a range of activities about the world that we live in and our local environments.



## Year 2

Have been focusing on the Oceans of the world. The children have been working on identifying different oceans of the world. With home learning children have been looking at compass points and following directions.



## Year 3

## Year 4
