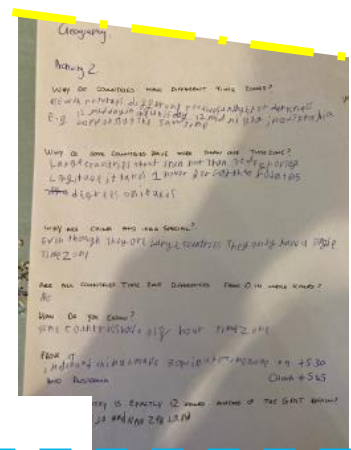
Year 1
