Little Jesters have been exploring sea creatures and investigating floating and sinking.

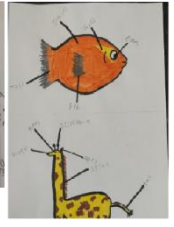
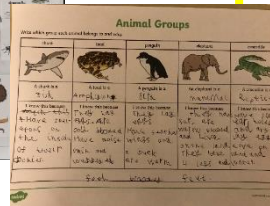
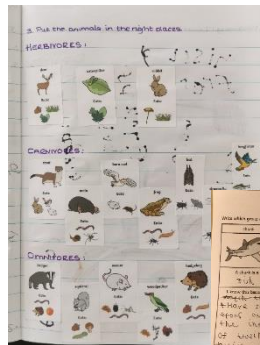


Year 2

Year 3

Year 3 had a hunt for invertebrates and vertebrates in their local environment and then used a key to classify the creatures they had found. They have also looked at the classification terminology.

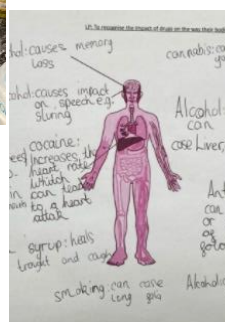


Year 4
