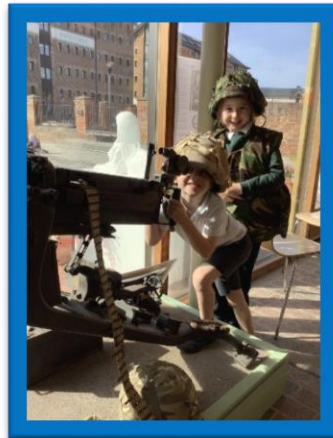


# Year 2 trip – The Soldiers of Gloucester Museum
