

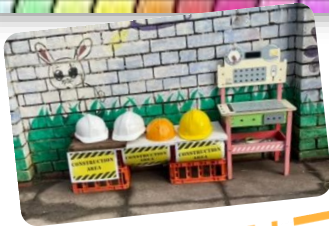


# "If Children are happy, they will achieve!" SUBJECT SNAPSHOT

## Reception

Reception have been fully engrossed in exploring their world. They have been looking at dinosaur environments. The children were loving building their own Berkeley town for the dinosaurs to roam around in.

## Year 2

Year 2 demonstrated a range of joining techniques such as gluing and using tape. They discovered some ways of joining were not strong enough and had to adapt their models of The Sydney Harbour Bridge. A range of cutting and shaping techniques were also a focus.



## Year 1

Year 1 have spent time looking at castles and their features and used this knowledge to design their own. They collected recycled materials and they found different ways to cut and join to build their castles.

## Year 3

This term, Year 3 have been measuring ingredients to the nearest gram and following a recipe. They have been learning all about Italy and so what better dish to create than mouth-watering pizza!



## Year 4

As part of their Egyptian theme, year 4 have been designing and creating a pair of papyrus sandals. They weaved together strips of paper to create the papyrus before using joining techniques for the finished product.

Year 5 have designed their own Mayan headdress. They have been making cross-curricular links with their material focus in science to design their piece and then chosen how to cut, shape and finally fasten together.
