This touched on the topic they had covered in the previous term about London and they enjoyed building Buckingham Palace and Big Ben again, using our construction resources. We also made some Jubilee fairy cakes, decorating them in red, white and blue. They had fun eating them at our mini Jubilee party! Afterwards we had a fun "horse race" on the field, as a tribute to the Queen's love of horses.

Little Jesters Highlights

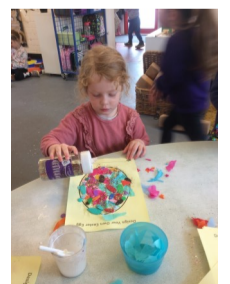
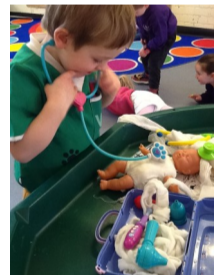
