SUBJECT SNAPSHOT



Reception have been learning about the Polar regions. They have found the Arctic and Antarctica on maps and globes. They have found out about the animals living there and how these places are different to England.



Little Jesters have been finding out about seasonal change. They have been learning about Autumn and Winter and what happens during these seasons.



Year 2 have been finding out about major cities in the United Kingdom. They have been using atlases and Google maps. They have also been looking at villages, towns and cities and what is similar and different about them.

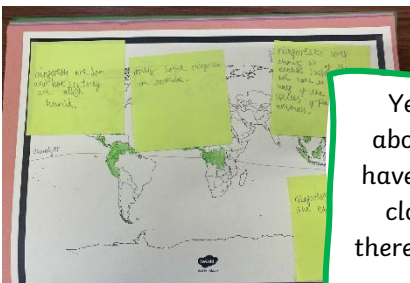


Year 1 have found out about the 7 continents and 5 oceans that make up planet Earth. They have used physical maps and Google Earth to find these and have found out which continent is the biggest and the smallest.



Year 3 have been finding out about tropical rainforests. They have found out about them being close to the Equator and that there is a high amount of sunlight and rainfall.

Year 4 have been using atlases to locate countries. They have focused on using the Index to help them. They have also been comparing landscapes, looking at both physical and human geography.



Year 5 have been learning about Ancient Greece. They have used atlases to look at modern day countries and cities on a map of Alexander the Great's empire. They also found out about Sparta and Athens and thought about the benefits of living in these areas.

Year 6 have found out about the old and the new seven wonders of the world today and then researched some of the natural wonders and manmade wonders of America. They have found out about places like The Grand Canyon, Mount Rushmore and the Statue of Liberty.
